Stratford District Council with partners have developed a number of cycle routes around the district, below are details of these routes.

Feldon and Ironstone Villages

This cycle route goes from Shipston-on-Stour to Southam and takes you through designated areas of natural beauty – it is a route of 25 miles each way, but can be done in sections.



Two Towns Cycle Route

This cycle route links the two Cotswold towns of Shipston-on-Stour and Moreton-in-Marsh – distance of 8 miles with a return route via the Four Shire Stone of 10 miles



Cotswold and Feldon Cycle Route

An attractive rural ride through Feldon countryside and villages with views of the Cotswolds starting in Shipston-on-Stour and finishing in Brailes – a distance of 14 miles, ride can be increased to include some challenging hills to add an additional 7 miles.



Stratford Greenway

This route takes you along the disused railway path from Stratford along the Greenway to Long Marston – a distance of 5 miles.

Bidford-on-Avon to Shipston-on-Stour (Circular Cycle Route)

Refreshments can be taken in Mickleton, Shipston or alternatively pop into Stratford upon Avon, good pubs along the way, rolling countryside nothing too challenging and very scenic. Biggest climb of the day is out of Mickleton to Ilmington.

Distance approx 40 miles

Duration between 2.5 and 4 hours depending on ability

Cotswold Route from Stratford-upon-Avon

This is a circular route with gentle rolling countryside commences in Stratford-upon-Avon and takes you to Broadway and returns through Chipping Campden.

Distance approx 39 miles

Duration approx 4 hours depending on ability
