Set in 150 acres of delightfully landscaped countryside, just outside Stratford-upon-Avon, The course here is an 18 tee 9 hole par 72 American Links style course. It measure 6,950 yards from back tees with a standard scratch of 72. American bent grass greens are fully irrigated with a host of water hazards throughout the course.

This picturesque 18 hole golf course is situated on a hillside overlooking the historic town of Henley in Arden and provides a fair test to all playing abilities. With wide fairways you're able to go for it off the tee, but placement is key for your approach shot.

The local scenery has been encapsulated beautifully to create a track that uses undulating fairways, fast greens and water features to challenge golfers.

Stratford Oaks is an 18 hole Par 71 course measuring 6232 yards from the white tees and 5377 yards from the red tees. It has been laid with USGA regulation greens that are manicured to perfection. Wide and long, they are big enough to accommodate a slightly wayward approach but fast enough to make you stop and think before putting out.

The cleverly designed course encompasses lakes, ponds, mounds and generous fairways and, whilst Stratford Oaks is an easy walk, due to its mildly undulating terrain, the challenge can be daunting, particularly when the wind blows. Meandering its way through Warwickshire countryside and conservation woodland, with trees providing definition between the holes, the layout avoids the up and down style that some courses succumb to. It is also a delightfully tranquil haven allowing golfers to appreciate their chosen sport in peace and quiet.

The 18 hole par 72 championship golf course, at 6575 yards with its full fairway irrigation system and USGA specification greens, is open all the year round. It has been designed to test all standards of golfers with. Our par 3 17th signature hole deserves a special mention, 203 yards over water to an island green.

Particular care has been taken to maintain the natural beauty of the Welcombe Hills. The planting of more than 50,000 trees and the use of lakes have helped to create areas that are ecologically friendly.

Visitors who savour the delights of the course and club appreciate that Ingon Manor is something very special. Apart from the course, further delights await around the clubhouse with attractive courtyards and patios. A leisurely drink here on a balmy summer's evening could be many a golfer's idea of paradise....
