This is an award winning ghost walk with magical entertainment in Shakespeare's Stratford-upon-Avon. Join The Man in Black, Vincent, Black Barrington or Josiah Grubb for an entertaining walk around the historic streets of Stratford. Discover the buildings where there are terrible tales and sinister stories of ghosts, witches, murder and misery. Hear about the witch who lived in a slum, the 17th century haunted tearoom and the phantom at the Royal Shakespeare Theatre. Don't go home alone tonight!

Ghost Walks start on Waterside just opposite the junction of Sheep Street and near the Royal Shakespeare Theatre. It is essential to reserve places in advance for this popular walk. Book early to avoid disappointment.
