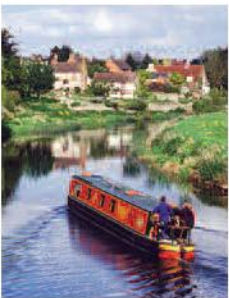




No Holds Bard

Day One

Start your day in the grounds of **Ragley Hall** near **Alcester**. Have a look at the **Jerwood Sculptures**, currently with twenty one sculptures set out along a two mile trail which includes the work of many reputable artists. After a leisurely walk through the collection, enjoy food in one of two on site cafes, or a self prepared picnic at the Lakeside Picnic Area.



After lunch catch a bus to the centre of **Stratford-upon-Avon** and walk up to the **Creaky Cauldron**. Here you will find the Museum of Wizardology, an unmissable treat for Harry Potter fans especially. The museum is full of strange magic and exciting encounters, and guarantees a fun afternoon. Before you leave, ask about the Victorian Imagiscarium and you may be able to book tickets for the spooky storytelling in the evening.



Take time to visit the town's many shops before dropping in on either **Greenhill Street Fish Bar** or **Kingfisher Fish Bar in Ely Street** to indulge in some classic tasty fish and chips.

If you are unable to book the Victorian Imagiscarium, why not take a look at what's taking place at **Cox's Yard** – Stratford's main local venue for music. From folk to rock to tribute bands, the venue caters for all different tastes. Although some events are 18+ entry, there are often events which have lower age restrictions for you to enjoy.

Day Two

Spend today at the **Skirmish Paintball** near **Alcester**, where you will battle alongside or against your friends in a number of different missions involving teamwork and strategy, in a variety of game zones. Lunch is available on site halfway through the games.



Catch a bus back to **Stratford** and treat yourself to food at **Pizza Hut** up at the Maybird Centre.

After tea, join the **Stratford Town Ghost Walk** which you should book in advance. This ghostly evening is sure to leave you in fright with stories of local ghouls and witches, and is guaranteed to be a fun filled and unique experience.
